



Improving Access to Genetic Testing

The Resonate™ Program provides genetic testing from Blueprint Genetics for eligible individuals with auditory neuropathy in the U.S. To help them understand their genetic testing results, participants also have access to optional genetic counseling provided by InformedDNA. These services are provided at no cost to participants, their insurance, or their healthcare providers.

A genetic diagnosis may help inform medical management and decision-making, as well as determine potential eligibility for clinical studies or future clinical trials.

Genetic Testing for Auditory Neuropathy

To be eligible for the Resonate Program, individuals must meet the following criteria:

- They have a current or prior clinical diagnosis of auditory neuropathy or a medical history consistent with auditory neuropathy. Auditory neuropathy is a hearing disorder characterized by an absent or abnormal auditory brainstem response with preservation of otoacoustic emissions (OAEs) and/or cochlear microphonics (CMs); and
- OAE and/or CM is present, or previously present; and
- They do not have evidence of a syndromic medical history

Comprehensive Genetic Testing

The Resonate Program 288-gene Hearing Loss and Deafness Panel is one of the most comprehensive available tests to potentially determine the underlying cause of genetic forms of hearing loss.

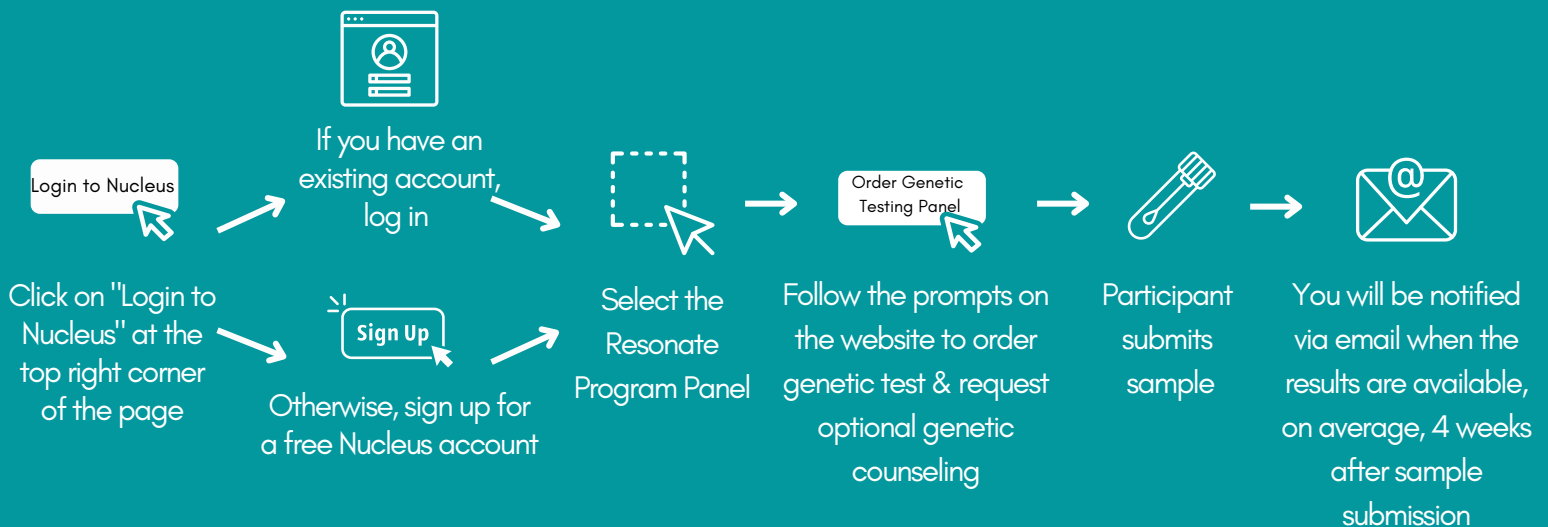
